


# Using Doink for Green Screen Videos


## Before you begin videoing

- Make sure you have an images or video for the **background**, **title slides**, and **credits** in the camera roll.
  - For images saved in Google Drive
    - Open the image
    - Make sure it fills the entire screen
    - Take a screenshot by pressing the buttons on top and bottom (home and on/off)
  - You can load an image from the ImageQuest database on the library website.  
<http://www.ghmslibrary.com/-databases.html>
    - Use the shortcut on the iPad 
    - UN: ghms / PW: library
    - Search for an image. Press down on selected image. Then choose Save.
    - Image will appear in the camera roll.
  - You can take a photo or video for the background with the iPad.
- Make sure your **script** is ready
  - Have the script in a **large font in Google Slides**, to use as a teleprompter
  - **Rehearse** the script so you'll be smooth and expressive when ready to video

## Creating the project and adding media

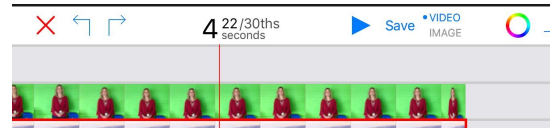


- Open Do Ink app
- Click on the + in upper right.
- Click **Create a New Project**.
- Click the + on the bottom line of the 3 lines at the bottom of the screen.
- Tap **Image or Video**, depending on which you want in the background.
- Choose the desired background image or video from the camera roll
  - Click **Use** from upper right.
- Click the + on the middle line of the 3 lines at the bottom of the screen.
- Tap **Camera**
  - Make sure the iPad is reversed (selfie style) so you can see yourself in front of the background.
  - Make sure everything fits in the frame, and there is nothing intruding (chairs, SmartBoard, etc.)
- Place a Chromebook as neat to the iPad on the tripod as possible.
  - Having it at eye level helps you look toward the camera
- Open the script and use the wireless mouse (or have a friend do it) to advance the script as you read.
- When ready, tap **Record**. The app will count down from 5 so you can prepare.

- Try to read/speak clearly, and not too fast.
- Make sure you are speaking loud enough.
- After one scene is completed, press the “stop recording” square.
- Click  to preview your video to make sure it is the way you want it. Then press Done.
- Save the video to the camera roll.
- Repeat the recording process until each segment is in the camera roll.



## Compiling and Editing the Project

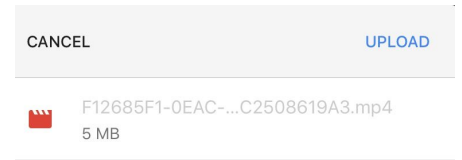
- In the **Do Ink** app, click **Create a New Project**.
- Click the **+** on the bottom line of the 3 lines at the bottom of the screen.
- Tap **Video and** insert the first segment.
- Choose the desired background image or video from the camera roll
  - Click **Use** from upper right.
- Add a **title slide**
  - **Swipe** the timeline until the vertical red line is at the spot where you want the title slide to appear (at the end of your first video clip).



- Tap the **+** at the right, choose **Image**, and add the title slide.
- **Swipe** the timeline until the vertical red line is about 4 frames in.
- **Tap** the bottom of the screen to make the tools appear.
- Make sure the bottom row is selected (red lines appear around it), and tap **Trim**.
- Continue adding video clips and title slides until all are in the timeline.
  - The final images should be the credits and citations for images that you saved on a Google Slide.
  - Trim the final images to 4 frames after the last video.

## Producing and Sharing the Project

- Click  to preview your video to make sure it is the way you want it.
- At the top left of the screen, click on the **Gear**. 
- Name the project.
- In the tool area, *above* the timeline, set on **Video** and click **Save**.
  - **Wait for the video to export.**
- Tap **Show the export options**.



- Choose **Google Drive**.

- Make sure it is signed in to the correct account.
- Select **My Drive**, then the desired folder.
- Click **Save here**.
- Click **Upload**.
- When you get the **Success** message, click **Done**.
- Click the back arrow at upper left to return to the start screen.
